RESOLUTION FOR LIBRARY MILLAGE RENEWAL

At a regular meeting of the Library Board for the Public Library for the City of Garden City held at the Garden City Public Library located at 31735 Maplewood St., Garden City, Mi 48135, Garden City, Michigan on the 10th day of April, 2018, at 7:00 p.m.

WHEREAS, in 2011 the voters of the City of Garden City approved 1 mill for the sole and exclusive purpose of providing for the operation and equipment of the City of Garden City Public Library under Section 10a of the City, Village and Township Libraries Act, Act 164 of the Public Acts of 1877 ("Act 164"), MCL 397.201, et seq for the period of 2012 through 2021, inclusive; and

WHEREAS, the Library Board has determined that a renewal of the existing 0.____ mill is necessary to further fund the operation and/or equipping of the Garden City Library for a period of ten (10) years under Act 164, MCL 397.201, et seq; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 10c of Act 164, MCL 397.210c, if a previously authorized library millage was approved for a specific number of years, the library governing board by resolution may determine that the millage should be renewed, the question of renewing the millage shall be placed on the ballot for approval by the electors at the next regular annual election for that city; and

WHEREAS, Public Act 248 of 1999, effective March 10, 2000, MCL 211.24f requires that any ballot for a millage renewal shall also indicate an estimate of the revenue the City shall collect in the first calendar year of the renewal if approved by the electorate.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that:

1. The Library Board has determined that a renewal of the existing library millage is necessary to further fund the Garden City Library under Section 10a of the City, Village and Township Libraries Act, Act 164 of the Public Acts of 1877 ("Act 164"), MCL 397.201, et seq. and the Library Board requests that the question of renewing the library millage be placed on the ballot for approval at the next regular annual election for that city; and

2. The ballot language to be submitted to a vote of the qualified electors of the City of Garden City, County of Wayne, Michigan, at a regular election to be held on the ___ day of August, 2018, shall be as follows:

CITY OF GARDEN CITY

LIBRARY MILLAGE PROPOSAL

Shall the tax limitation imposed on all taxable real and tangible personal property within the City of Garden City, Wayne County, Michigan, be renewed in an amount not to exceed 0. Mill (\$0. on each \$1,000.00 of taxable value) for a period of ten (10) years, _____ to _____ inclusive, pursuant to Section 10c of Act 164 of Public Acts of 1877 (as amended) MCLA 397.210c. to provide funds for the operation and/or equipping of a City of Garden City Public Library and for all other library purposes authorized by law; said millage would be a renewal of a previously authorized millage for such purpose and the estimated amount of revenue that will be collected by the City in the first year that the millage is authorized and levied is approximately \$_____.
