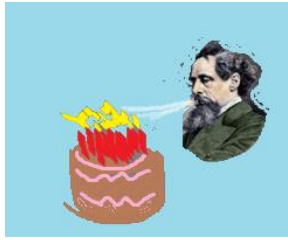

THE LITERARY BIRTHDAY SPOTLIGHT



- **September 29, 1923 - Stan Berenstain:** Stan was one of the authors of The Berenstain Bears book series. His editor was none other than Dr. Seuss!
- **October 5, 1952 - Clive Barker:** In addition to authoring books, this GLADD Award recipient was the creator of horror movies such as ‘Candyman’ and ‘Underworld’.
- **November 29, 1832 - Louisa May Alcott:** This classic author was the first woman to vote in Concord, MA. She was required to take a literacy test before submitting her ballot.
